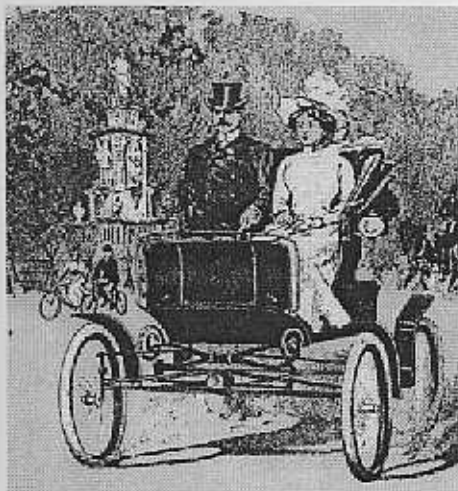

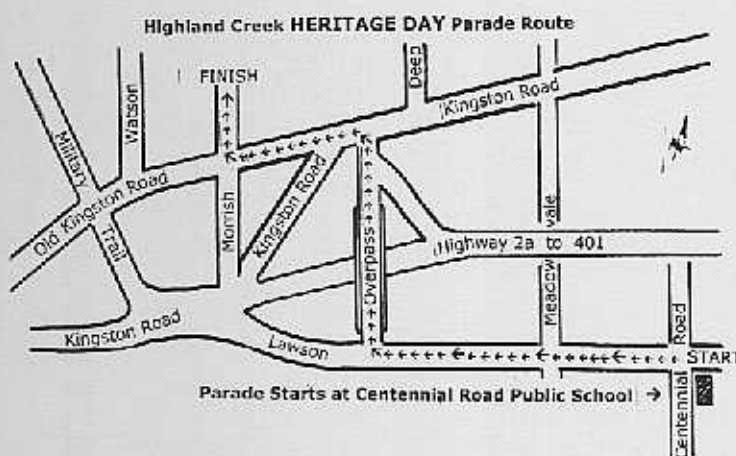
Parade starts at 11:00 a.m.
